Saranac Lake ArtWorks, the new sponsor for this event, welcomes you to the **5TH ANNUAL ARTIST AT WORK STUDIO TOUR**, featuring over 50 artists at 34 locations in the Tri-Lakes area. The booklet is designed for Studio Tour, but also serves as the year-round "Guide to Regional Artists". Please note that most listings are for private studios, and, while open to the public during the Studio Tour, they are "by appointment only" the rest of the year. Galleries and shops do have regular business hours. Note: Not all studios are open all 3 days. Check the listing carefully.

Learn first hand how artists really work – there are painters (oil, watercolor, acrylic & pastel), photographers, ceramic and fiber artists, a blacksmith, a wood carver, printmakers, jewelry designers, and artists who work in mixed media. New this year – a group of poets will be reading their works at the Lake Placid Library - Sunday only. Speak with the artists and see the creative process first hand. Bring home a unique work of art!

The end of September is peak fall foliage season in the Adirondacks. Plan a route to travel and enjoy the art of nature as well as the creations of the artists. Consider one day to tour the Village of Saranac Lake where half of the studios are located, many of which can be reached by walking. Plan the other days for scenic drives to the other communities and artist locations. Watch for Artist at Work signs. Use this booklet to make your selections and get specific directions.

Studio Tour Central is the Adirondack Artists' Guild Gallery, Saranac Lake. Pick up booklets, get questions answered, or come meet Guild members who will also be demonstrating. On Friday, from 5-7, meet regional artists at the Lake Placid Center for the Arts opening reception of the Adirondack Juried Show. Tune in to North Country Public Radio while you travel.
