Aug 14	Noon - 7 pm - Artists may check in at the Adirondack Artists Guild Gallery 52 Main St, Saranac Lake. Get surfaces stamped. NO PAINTING - until sunset when Nocturne Contest begins, sponsored by NorthWind Fine Arts. 11x14 or smaller. Framed paintings due at NorthWind by 4 pm on Thursday. 11 Woodruff St.
Aug 15	"Paint the VIC" Day at the Paul Smith's College VIC. Artists not checked in may do so at 8 am and get their surfaces stamped at the VIC. 8023 State Route 30 Paul Smiths, New York 12970 518-327-6241 (1 mile north of intersection of routes 86 and 30. On left.)
	NOTE: to get surfaces stamped on other days, you may go to the Adirondack Artists Guild Gallery between 10 - 5 pm.
Aug 16	"Paint the Adirondacks" Day. Artists are free to choose their own locations to paint. Maps and directions will be included in your registration packets.
	NOTE: you might want to take time to paint in the Lake Placid area as there will be a special prize available (see prize info).
Aug 17	"Paint the Town" Day. Artist are expected to paint in the Village of Saranac Lake. Paint the lakes, the river, the historic downtown, & other locations.
	OPTIONAL: Donate a small painting (11x14 or smaller, UNFRAMED) for our Annual Silent Auction to benefit the art program in the Saranac Lake Schools. Artists will receive 1/2 the sale price. Free 5x7 canvases available. 4 pm: Donated "Paint the Town" (UNFRAMED, 11x14 or smaller) paintings due at Adirondack Artists Guild Gallery 4 pm: Nocturnes due at NorthWind Fine Arts (FRAMED, 11x14 OR smaller). \$100 prize awarded at 6 pm.
	5 - 7:30 pm: 3rd Thursday ArtWalk. Previously scheduled artists, crafts people, and musicians will be set up downtown. PAF artists are NOT required to participate, but if you do set up to paint somewhere, it will help attract people to our Show & Sale! Send people to the Artists Guild Gallery for more info!

Aug 18	"Paint the Saranac River" Day - the Saranac Lake Fish & Game Club property will be open to artists for painting beginning at sunrise. See map for location. 726 Bloomingdale Ave (Route 3), Saranac Lake.

	<p>6 - 9 pm: SPECIAL PREVIEW PARTY - artists (and a guest) admitted free; tickets \$20; 8 PM awards presented. Town Hall, 39 Main St.</p>
<p>Aug 19</p>	<p>10 am - noon: Quick Draw competition - all artists are eligible; please check in at Adirondack Artists Guild Gallery for a “Quick Draw Number”, between 9 - 10 am, prior to setting up.</p>
	<p>Noon -12:15 pm: Bring paintings and your easel to set up on sidewalk out in front of the Town Hall. Put your number on your easel. Prizes awarded.</p>
	<p>Noon - 5 pm: SHOW & SALE in the Town Hall open to the public. No admission charge. Lunch will be available inside for artists. Artists are asked to be present. Saranac Lake ArtWorks will handle all sales.</p>
